As our 7-year anniversary in Tanzania rapidly approaches, we cannot help but reflect on how the Lord has transformed us and the ministry He called us to. Truly, the Lord has done absolutely astounding things in and through us for His honor and glory. Honestly, we could never have imagined we would find ourselves in this place. Our mistakes and missteps over the years remind us that our meager efforts are not the cause of the transformation. Surely, the Lord heard and honored the prayers of faithful saints offered on our behalf, as well as those of the people we serve. It is in this context that we renew our request for you to continue to pray for us, the ministry, and the loyal and devoted ministry workers. Following are specific areas to pray for.

Levels 1-4 Inductive Bible Study Seminars. Pray for the instructors as they conduct 15-20 IBS seminars across Tanzania each month. The hours are long and mentally taxing, and the travel is dangerous—a number have sustained serious injuries. Also, please pray for the five new certified instructors for our Level 3 and 4 seminars where


we teach Biblical preaching to pastors and overseers and also select prospective Bible College students. May they have wisdom and discernment in selecting new students.

Travel in Tanzania is dangerous because of road conditions, shared types of traffic, and unsafe vehicles.

Intensive Care Ministries Bible College. Please pray for the principals, instructors, workers, and students of the college. The Diploma in Pastoral Ministry program consists of five sessions (semesters) that take place over the course of 30 months, encompassing about 550 contact hours in the classroom. There is also significant course work required of each student between the sessions. After launching the college just last year, we now have four campuses. We have an extremely ambitious program this year with 20 sessions scheduled, involving 11 separate co-ed classes of students across the four campuses. That means there are usually 2 sessions per month occurring somewhere! It requires a lot of administration and finances to make it happen, but we step out in faith.



Women's Seminars. We are close to launching the women's seminar program where will we use female instructors to conduct 3-day women-only seminars. There will be two days of IBS instruction and one day of women-unique topics. Please pray for our instructor training this month and the commissioning of the four Tanzanian women who will make up our initial cadre of instructors.

Our Local Church—Believers Fellowship Baptist

Church. Jim continues to co-pastor, and Janice leads the children's Sunday School program and serves as church treasurer. Pray for these efforts, as well as the Lord's guidance as we embark on a modest building program to transform our current worship site from having only 2 walls to being completely enclosed with 4 walls, windows and doors! Prayers are also desired for this church to be a light within the city—a place where people come to hear sound teaching and commit their lives to Christ.



Eden Garden Secondary School. Please continue to pray for the Sunday worship service at this high school. We have students from various faith backgrounds attending, and we're praying for lives to be transformed and Godly leaders to emerge.



<u>Training for Life</u>. The Lord has brought us a delightful group of 24 students for this 3.5 month life skills program where we serve as chaplains. A number are seeking the Lord, so please pray for them to receive Jesus as their Lord Savior.
